CSCI120C, CSCI120D and CSCI120E are being offered online. All the reading and assignments for the course will be available on the C4 website:

The online courses are intended to serve students with excellent self-motivation and time management skills who may have difficulty attending the course in person during the week. The online sections will not be less work than the in-class sections - in fact, because there won't be a scheduled class time for you to attend in person, the online course will require a little extra dedication from you to ensure you stay on top of the workload. At the start of the semester, if you don't already have an account on [the C4 system](#), go to the above website, and follow the instructions to set up a new account. Once you have an account, navigate to the Computer Science course you signed up for (in the Summer 2019 Semester this is either CSCI120C, CSCI120D or CSCI120E). Enter the enrolment key when requested.

The enrolment key for CSCI120C is: **dragon345** (all lowercase)
The enrolment key for CSCI120D is: **dragon456** (all lowercase)
The enrolment key for CSCI120E is: **dragon567** (all lowercase)

Note: These enrolment keys will expire at the end of Week 3 of the semester. Students joining any of these courses after Week 3 should contact the instructor directly by email: adawson@coquitlamcollege.com or moconnor@coquitlamcollege.com
